What a year 2020 was! Victims Assistance Center (VAC) was not immune to the impact of COVID-19 but managed to adapt. The Center continued delivering services by utilizing available technology to continue meeting client needs. For the 2020 calendar year over 7,500 community members received services, almost 2,000 were children, and the agency's hotline saw a 100% increase in calls.

VAC is 96% grant-funded and budgets have been impacted by the COVID-19 pandemic. This past year we cancelled our two special annual events thus leaving the agency underfunded for 2021. This reality led us to a COVID-friendly fundraising idea--The 100 Campaign. VAC is looking for 100 supporters (individuals or groups) passionate about ending abuse in our community. These 100 supporters will get creative in finding ways to raise \$1,000 throughout the year.
