Author Jeffery Deaver wrote "It's a tough life. And It's the little things that get us through the day." People often come to us with few personal belongings, fleeing for their safety. Not knowing what they need; just wanting the abuse to stop. Confused, afraid, and alone. Through the years we have realized that sometimes it's the "little things" we do to help survivors that truly makes a difference in their lives.

It's helping them get a new copy of their birth certificate or driver's license because their abuser is withholding theirs. It's making sure their children are ready for back to school, and buying them school supplies, backpacks, new clothes and shoes. It's finding an apartment for them that is safe, and affordable, and helping them move in. It's shopping with them for household items they need for their fresh start; pots and pans, dishes, utensils, bedding, blankets, and cleaning supplies. It's walking over to family court with them to file a petition for an order of protection and answering all their questions. It's sitting at the kitchen table at our shelter with them when it is 2am and they can't sleep. It's all the little things that are done every day to help a survivor take steps on their path to healing and safety.
